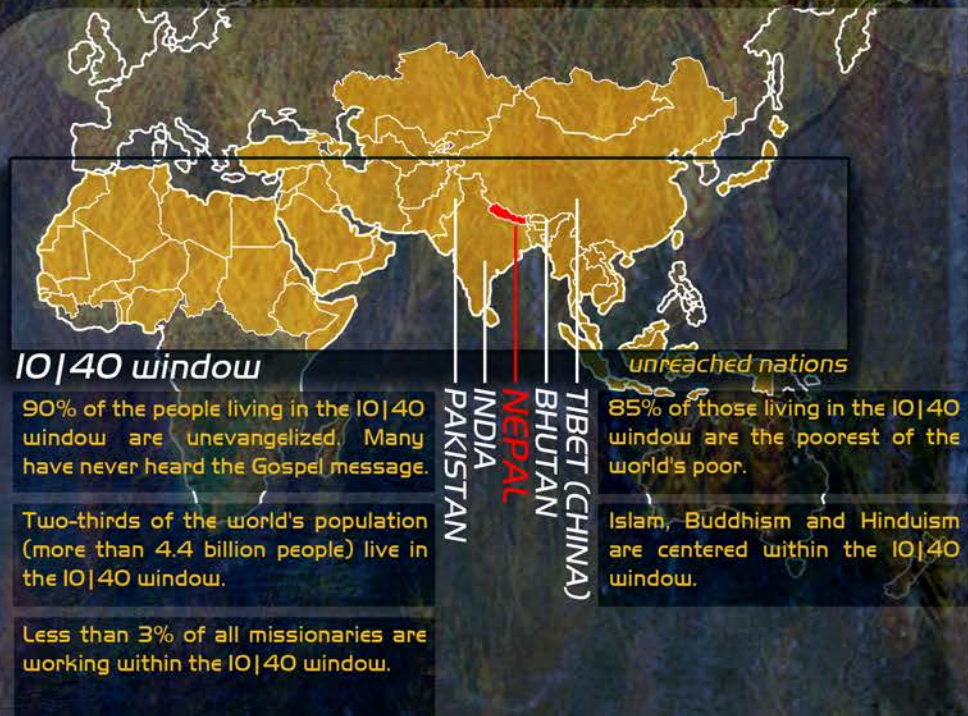
We are mobilizing for our second session of Dunamis School of Ministry in Kathmandu, Nepal. Last year's pioneering laid the foundation for increase as we begin again this August. Nepal lies further within the heart of Asia than any place I've been in the past thirteen years, and the impact of working in such an unreached area has been truly phenomenal. The effect of the school on the lives of those who attended was rewarding and even humbling. God is not looking for our ability, but for our obedience in response to His!

Only one example of many is the student who told me that he had been given a hand written tract when he was just a child telling him about Jesus. The giver had instructed him to copy the tract over and give it to someone else, which he did! All the years he wanted to know this Jesus but "didn't know how to do it." Can you imagine? He waited years to find someone who could lead him in a prayer of salvation! This is a common story in the nations of the 10|40 window, and the reason we are compelled to train laborers for God's harvest.

A predominantly Hindu nation, Nepal stands today at a critical point of change. Although less than 1% of the population is Christian, the Church is strong, having persevered through great persecution. Just after our first trip to this nation in 2008, Nepal began the historic transition from Hindu Kingdom to secular state. The present interim constitution allows freedom to worship but not yet to proselytize. Nepal like many other nations in our day is struggling to write laws and a constitution which will allow peace and prosperity to reign. Dark influences have held people captive to fear for centuries and it is vital at this time that the Church stand upon the Word of God and take her place as salt and light.

We are expecting God to bring us key leaders and pastors through whom the Word will multiply. This project is too big for just a few of us! To add our light to this nation we need your supply of faith, prayer and financial partnership. Our desire is to take full advantage of this open door of opportunity and equip many to bring change in their regions.

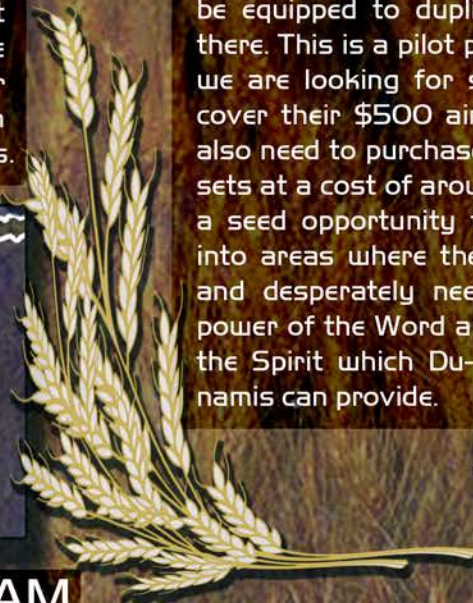
BUILDING A STRONG LOCAL CHURCH SEMINAR

REACHING SURROUNDING NATIONS

I met "Pastor A." in Manila and we discussed the need for a Bible School in his nation which is constantly in the news and not yet open to the Gospel. We are endeavoring to bring three leaders in to attend Dunamis who, after training, will be equipped to duplicate our program there. This is a pilot program for us and we are looking for sponsors who will cover their \$500 airfare to Nepal. We also need to purchase translation headsets at a cost of around \$2000. This is a seed opportunity to help us expand into areas where the church struggles and desperately needs the power of the Word and the Spirit which Dunamis can provide.
